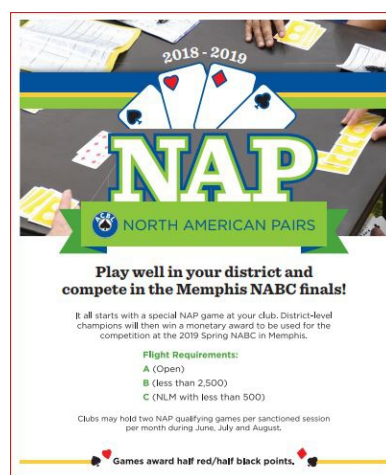


District 20 North American Pairs 2018 - 2019

Schedule:

- Club level: Qualifying games may be held in June, July and August.
- Unit level: Is not conducted in District 20. Units may sponsor a club-qualifying game.
- District level: Is conducted online via BBO at venues throughout D20 – two sessions.
Flights A & C, Saturday, October 20, 2018; 11:00 am PDT. 2nd session TBA.
Flight B, Sunday, October 21, 2018; 11:00 am PDT. 2nd session TBA.
- National level: At the [Spring NABC](#) in Memphis, TN, March 21-31, 2018.

Flight Eligibility:

- Flight A: Open to any player
- Flight B: Players with less than 2500 MP's as of June 2018.
- Flight C: Non-LifeMaster (NLM) with fewer than 500 MP's as of June 2018.

***** Flight Eligibility is determined by the June 2018 masterpoint cycle *****
(published by the ACBL on May 6, 2018)

NAP FAQ's

Frequency:

- Clubs may hold two NAP games per sanctioned session during each of the months of June, July and August.

Masterpoints:

- 50/50 red/black
- Click here for [Masterpoint Award Chart](#)

Fees:

- \$5.00 per table, U. S. funds

Sanction:

- No special sanction required, just choose the game in ACBLScore, DBADD to include masterpoints and fees with your club's month end report.

Stratification:

- Stratification information is found in Appendix V of the NAP Conditions of Contest.

ACBLScore Set-up:

- Detailed instructions found in the Game Set-up – ACBLScore and Your Club Game Document.
- It's important to remember if your game includes the C level, select NLM for the upper masterpoint limit. After entering the players' names, use Strat command to check the masterpoint holding of the C pairs. If anyone has over 500 masterpoints, you need to change them to the B level.

Invitational Clubs:

- An invitational club (a club opened to members only) may conduct a NAP qualifying game:
- Under its usual rules and award of masterpoints at 80% of an open club or,
- May, with unit permission and appropriate publicity, hold an open qualifying game for any NAP flight provided the game is open to any ACBL member fitting any applicable flight participation requirements • The masterpoints are all black for invitational games.

Qualifying Lists:

- Each club should send a qualifying list to their district NAP coordinator after all games have been held at the end of August. The instructions are included in the Game Set-up – ACBLScore and your Club Game instructions.
- D20 does not require unit qualifying.
