**C**oho salmon ("silvers") have silver sides and dark-blue backs during their ocean phase. During spawning their jaws and teeth become hooked. In fresh water, they develop bright-red sides, bluish-green heads and backs, dark bellies and dark spots on their backs. They range along both sides of the North Pacific, from Hokkaidō, Japan and eastern Russia, around the Bering Sea to mainland Alaska, and south to Monterey Bay, California. It is one of the most popular sport fish in the Pacific Northwest of the U.S. and Canada. Its habit of schooling in relatively shallow water, and often near beaches, makes it accessible to anglers on the banks, as well as in boats. In November 1997, a Portland television station and The Oregonian teamed with the Oregon chapter of the American Meteorological Society in a contest to name the strong Columbia River Gorge winds. Some 7,000 entries were submitted, with a total of 2,424 different names. The name 'Coho' was judged to be the best name.

- Treat your new puppy with respect and love if you want an enduring relationship.
- Catch your puppy doing something RIGHT.
- Remember, sometimes you need to leave your puppy alone to play.
- Keep training sessions short, otherwise your puppy will lose interest.
- Small morsels of food are useful in modeling good behavior.
- Your puppy cannot learn a new command right away.
- Never use harsh words. Your puppy is trying to do the right thing. If he isn't learning, it's YOUR fault!
