
Vancouver Bridge Club Computer Set-Up



PC-1 (the smaller unit on the portable frame) will be used for running games using ACBLScore and BOS (BridgeMate Operating System). Results can be printed using the shared printer over the network. Results posting will be through The Common Game interface, TCGMerge.

PC-2 (the large unit on the portable frame) will be used for the dealing machine, for creating deals when necessary, for creating and printing the cash report, and for managing the three (3) auxiliary displays. The printer is directly attached to this computer.

Disp1 is the primary display for PC-2, located on the left of the director's table (next to north wall).

Disp2 is located next to the dealing machine and should be used almost exclusively for this task.

Disp3 is the screen on the second shelf. It's image is also shown on **Disp3a**, the large TV screen mounted on the wall. These are intended to show information for the players such as the weekly slide show and game final results.

Disp4 is a round timer. Suggested location is TBD.

The two PC's are connected to the internet and to each other via ethernet. They can share information in several ways: local network for printer sharing, Dropbox, and Team Viewer. Recommended method for displaying results on the big screen (**Disp3/3a**) is still being determined.

Images from **Disp1** can be moved to **Disp2**, **Disp3/3a**, or **Disp4** by grabbing the image and dragging it from left to right and dropping it on the desired display.

Please leave the PC's on 24/7 to allow for remote troubleshooting. Here are the user names and passwords for the two PC's in case a power outage requires a reboot:
